Parishes throughout England and Wales are required to hold an Annual Meeting of the Parish (APM) between 1st March and 1st June each year. Where there is a parish council, it is often the chairman of the council which convenes this meeting.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the APM is to update the electors on all matters within the parish, not just the Parish Council, and provide a forum for registered electors to discuss anything they consider to be of importance to the people of the Parish.

WHO CAN ATTEND?

This is a meeting for all the local government electors of the parish. This is NOT a meeting of the Parish Council. Anyone may attend, similarly to a Parish Council meeting, however only registered electors of the Civil Parish of Woodcote may vote.
